Greetings in the name of our Lord. Thank you for your help in every way. Your prayers, your financing, and your works make BICA possible. Central America thanks you!

Suppose each of us had the ability and desire to give away a million dollars every day to strangers. We would change lives in tremendous ways. Needed doctor care would be theirs. Dreams could be realized. They would be so happy. They would thank us a thousand times, but “that ain’t nothin’.” Suppose instead we give them eternal life! Most of us do not have millions of dollars to give away. We all have the Gospel. It is free to us and free for others. They will thank us in eternity. I thank you a thousand times for helping us to give the Gospel to the many. I think there will be hugging in heaven.

Nicaragua reports for March: Campaign in Bluefields—15 baptisms, 8 restored; weekends—32 baptisms, 22 restored; Wednesdays—7 baptisms, 1 restored; Erick—4 baptisms, 5 restored. Total 61 baptized, 37 restored = 98 saved.

I am sad to report the death of one of our beloved students in Nicaragua. Eddy Peña, a 46-year-old brother, died of a stroke. He was very poor. BICA bought his casket, etc. His son is also a first-year student. Another son and nephews have graduated.

Honduras reports: 24 baptisms and 18 restorations in various works. Total: 42 saved.

Guatemala: Had two campaigns: #1. Six small churches in El Salvador—34 baptisms, 12 restorations. #2. El Milagro church in Guatemala City—55 baptized, 18 restored. Weekends (2) 19 baptized, 29 restored; 26 are being taught to teach others. Totals: 108 baptized, 59 restored = 167 total saved.

All three schools’ totals: 193 baptisms, 111 restored = 304 saved.

Contact me very soon if you want to be with us on the June 22-29 campaign in Nicaragua (281-252-4444) With God’s help, we will start with nothing, and at the end of the week the new saints will gather. We expect 15-40 people.
