In Guatemala, the churches came together on Easter week for fellowship and edification. Around 2,500 attended this year. The church in Guatemala purchased 11 acres for a campsite. It will be the place for the new house church the students started by baptizing 19 that week. For March, they baptized 46 and restored 48. That's 94 saved in Guatemala. Three schools total—201 saved in March.

BICA Honduras reports that they started a new church in the mountains near Marcala, La Paz, Honduras. This is rugged territory. The houses were far apart. Thanks to God, 10 were saved. They had another campaign plus their regular weekend work. Fifty-five were saved by baptizing 23 and restoring 30.

BICA Nicaragua reports starting 8 house churches this year. (In 2016 we expect the starting of well over 100 new churches in homes by our students and the 451 graduates.) The students baptized 40 and restored 12 = 52 saved. The school had two evangelistic campaigns this month. Erick Garcia was greatly hurt by the death of his grandmother. She died as a result of a medical mistake. Pray for the family.
