Honorable Brethren,

Greetings in Jesus. The Bible directs us to examine ourselves in II Corinthians 13:5, also to prove ourselves. Question: Can we prove that our concern, passion, and work is like that of Jesus? As a baby, He was called "God With Us." Why was the baby "God With Us"? He came to save His people from their sins. That is easy to understand. As we look upon every page of the Gospels, we see Jesus showing compassion for the lost. He and John baptized the multitudes—for the remission of sins—see Mark 1:4 and John 4:1-2. That is easy to understand. Then in the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:15,16) Jesus gave His last instructions. He claimed ALL AUTHORITY. He said to take the Gospel to all. He commanded faith, repentance, and baptism to be SAVED. He is always correct! Now that is not hard to understand. How do we prove ourselves?

Where our money is indicates where our heart is. Everyone says that the church has turned inward. Where is our heart? Eighty percent of budget is for selves. Missions equal 2 % or 5% or 7% or 12% or 15%, etc. What does our money—spending habit say about us? It tells the truth. Please help us financially. We have lost money to building projects, more staff members, etc. Thank you for your heart for missions. Remember: It's all about the lost—not us.

Honduras reports: 2 campaigns: El Aquacatal and Santa Ana. Thirteen students suffered from body pains and fever, yet 19 were baptized and 19 restored. Weekend work: 13 baptized, 8 restored. Glory to God!

Guatemala reports: campaign in the dangerous area El Milagro, Mixco. 21 baptized (see photos below), 11 restored. Weekends total—24 baptisms, 53 restored. BEST OF ALL, 51 are being taught to teach others.

Nicaragua: From one campaign and house churches totals are 14 baptisms, 9 restored.
